Employer will provide shirt and visor which are to be returned before you leave the area at the end of your program. Students are required to bring/purchase black pants (no jeans or sweat pants) & wear non-slip, close-toed, black shoes which can be purchased from Wal-Mart, Payless Shoes or on-line from Shoes for Crews ( <a href="http://www.shoesforcrews.com">www.shoesforcrews.com</a> ). Cost approx. \$30 or less. If you would like for the employer to order your pants and shoes for you, they will be happy to do that. You just need to email them your exact confirmed arrival information along with your shoe and pants sizes. If you ask them to order them for you, the cost of them will be deducted from your first paycheck. You must make this request for shoes, pants or both at least 2 week prior to arriving.
