Job description and required skills: Insure patron safety, maintain filtration system & pool chemistry, keep pool and surrounding areas clean (including restrooms) Keep pool area safe and ensure gate control. Provide customer service when necessary. Students must pass a safety/lifeguard training course, Community First Aid, and CPR for the Professional Rescuer. This course lasts 3 days and costs \$199.00. May be paid from the employees first couple of paychecks. You must swim 300 meters, retrieve a 5 Kg Brick from a 3 meter depth and swim with it above the water for 20 meters and then climb out of the pool unassisted. Pass a written and skills test based on the material covered in the course. MUST work through September 5th.
