Girls: 1 stud earring in each ear are all of the visible piercings allowed while working (this includes no tongue rings while working), nails must be kept well groomed no bold colors, anyone with long hair must keep it pulled up and back off of shoulders and away from face. Guys: must be clean cut with short hair, no visible piercings (this includes no tongue rings while working), no facial hair, no colored nail polish. Employer will provide shirt and visor which are to be returned before you leave the area at the end of your program. Students are required to bring/purchase black pants (no jeans or sweat pants) & wear non-slip, close-toed, black shoes which can be purchased from Wal-Mart, pay-less Shoes or on-line from Shoes for Crews (www.shoesforcrews.com). Cost approx. \$30 or less. If you would like for the employer to order your pants and shoes for you, they will be happy to do that. You just need to email them your exact confirmed arrival information along with your shoe and pants sizes. If you ask them to order them for you, the cost of them will be deducted from your first paycheck. You must make this request for shoes, pants or both at least 2 week prior to arriving.
Additional information:	There are 2 locations in Williamsburg and they are located 2 miles apart from one another. All Williamsburg students will check in at the 2nd Street location listed on this job offer, then you will be assigned to either this same store or the store down the street. The chance to change positions will be based on your work performance, as well as the needs of the business at the time.
