On any shift when you work more than 9 ½ hours you will receive an additional \$7.25 for the shift. In any week you work more than 40 hours you will receive \$11.025 per hour for those hours over 40.</p> <p>Scheduled work week The work week is from Monday to Sunday and the schedule will be posted on Thursday.</p> <p>Requests for time off and work hours</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Requests must be in writing and handed in no later than the Wednesday prior to the schedule posting day (Thursday). Time off will be given if we have enough employees to work your normal shift. 2. Once the schedule is posted no changes will be made. 3. We do hire friends and will try to make sure you work the same shifts but your scheduled days off may be different. 4. You must honor your contract and show up to work on your scheduled shifts. If you do not show up for a scheduled shift and did not call in advance to say you cannot make it, your contract will be terminated and your visa will be revoked. 5. When it rains we need very few people to work. Rather than showing up to work and be sent home, we want you to call the restaurant to see if you are required to work on that day. Also, if it starts raining during your shift you may be sent home early. You can make up the lost hours by working an extra day on your normal day off or working a longer shift on sunny and warm days. You can also make up the hours by doing other jobs in the restaurant such as cooking, cleaning and kitchen work. |
