<b>Conditions of training:</b>	Training is not paid; there is a fee of \$275.00 per person for training which the employer will deduct from from your first couple of pay checks. To become a certified lifeguard or pool operator, you will need to pass a swimming test, which includes: swimming 500 yards (approximately 480 meters); surface diving to a depth of 7 – 10 feet (approx. 2.1 – 3 meters); and retrieving a 10 pound object (approx. 4.5 kilograms) & returning it to the surface. Participation in a lifeguard training course is required as well; upon successful completion, employees will receive the Cardio Pulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) certificate, which is valid for 1 year, & the American Red Cross Lifeguard training & First Aid certificate, which is valid for 3 years.

You must stay until your stated end date. If you wish to take a short travel time, then between July 5th and July 25th, you may request a 3-4 day vacation. Short vacations will only be offered during that time frame. You must request your vacation in writing at least 2 weeks prior to the time you would like off. (Employer reserves the right to change this policy at anytime).
