<b>How soon after arrival will participants begin working?</b>	Start date may vary from DS date; students will be given a start date on arrival
<b>Specific instructions for arrival to employer:</b>	Students should not expect to start training on the weekend. Training will be during the week on weekday mornings only (Monday-Thursday). Your official start date will be scheduled once you arrive to the employer. Start dates may vary several days from your DS date. Please be patient and allow the employer to integrate you into the schedule. Students will be given a date to start training as soon as they arrive. Students who arrive during the Memorial Day holiday 5/26 to 5/29 will not be able to start immediately.

Must wear closed toed athletic shoes and khaki trousers. As the weather gets warm, khaki short trouser are allowed. They must come to the knee. Beach Arcade will provide 2 T-Shirts for free. No visible piercings (including no tongue rings). Any employee with long hair must have it up and off their shoulders. No visible tattoos. Only clear nail polish is permitted; nails must be kept short and well groomed. Natural looking hair color only. Culturally in the US, it is considered unsanitary not to shower every day. It is important to shower, wear antiperspirant and clean your clothes daily.

premises, the landlord may deduct the damages from the tenant who caused the damage, or the landlord may choose to deduct money from all of the tenants' deposits. Participants should understand the return of this deposit is conditional and may not be returned. This deposit may be retained by the landlord for the following: any unpaid rent or utility bills; payment for damages to the premises; any cleaning; failure to remove any collected trash and food waste from the premises at least once a week; failure to remove trash from the premises which requires pest control professionals; failure to remove ALL collected trash and food waste from the premises before departure; failure to remove collected trash in the yard or street area around or near to the premises, including trash disturbed by birds or animals; disturbances to neighboring premises from parties or loud noise; leaving the premises prior to the end of the negotiated term. Program Coordinators cannot negotiate the return of a security deposit if the landlord/tenant agreement has been broken.

Students will be required to furnish their Social Security cards prior to receiving their first paycheck. It is the student's obligation to "promptly" show the card to the employer upon receipt. Students will only be eligible for direct deposit once the employer receives a copy of the student's Social Security card. Paychecks will not be issued until the employer receives a copy of the student's SS card. Be PREPARED to have a housing deposit, spending money, and rent for three weeks before receiving your first paycheck.

# Beach Arcade

Adaptation is not always easy, working is hard, but it is important to remember that you are temporarily in the United States for a new learning experience. The key to a successful program is to stay positive and be flexible.



The concept of time plays a great role in American culture. Being late consistently makes you unreliable. Come to work as scheduled and on time. Good attendance ensures your hours.



No job, or hours at a job, can be 100% guaranteed. Regardless of what your work contract states, there is always a possibility that you will work more or less hours. Expect lower hours during the first two weeks of training.



Participants should have a high tolerance for environmental noise. Arcades can be loud at peak times.




Participants should love children and have the patience to deal with difficult children or parents.



Participants who accept the position, must be physically able push, pull, and lift 15 kgs with no physical limitations. Requires standing for long periods of time.



Beach Arcade will not change your schedule to accommodate your second job. Second jobs must be approved by CHI prior to starting. Your CHI coordinator will help you with this process. Your second job can not conflict with your primary job. If you have a conflict, your primary employer will not guarantee 32 hours.



Open a bank account and get a debit card. Do not carry cash, valuables or your documents with you. Bring an alternative ID to carry. Keep your passport and documents stored safely at your housing.



Participants should use common sense, stay with a partner or friend, especially at night. It is recommended participants let a friend know where they are.



Bicycle riders with helmets had an 85 percent reduction in their risk of head injury and an 88 percent reduction in their risk of brain injury. If you ride a bicycle in the US, wear a helmet.




The city of Rehoboth Beach holds safety orientations for all Work & Travel participants. Participants should attend at least one of these meetings. Check with your coordinator for date and times.



You must arrange your own housing. We recommend you search for your housing prior to arrival. Be prepared with an arrival plan. Do not arrive late at night.



A security deposit protects landlords from the cost associated with; parties, loud noise, damage, dirt, trash, unpaid rent, or utility bills. Participants who leave housing before the end of their program will \*NOT\* see any portion of their security deposit returned. Your refund is conditional, CHI coordinators can not negotiate a return.



Participants should be aware the United States is a melting pot. You will come into contact with all kinds of people and ways of life. All ages, shapes and sizes, levels of wealth, backgrounds, religions, sexual preferences, and ethnicities.
